Artisanal Design

What defines artisanal design? In short, hallmarks include original, one-of-a-kind creations that are hand-made and not mass produced. Essentially, there is one degree of separation between the maker and the collector and that relationship is a unique one, specifically in the way it changes how a space looks and feels. Design that incorporates and favors artisanal design over a “one of many” approach tends to feel ripe with story, authenticity, provenance, depth, texture, and the maker’s signature craftsmanship.
