The new pieces expand on some of the ideas from the original launch blending classic and modern motifs with unparalleled craftsmanship, to fashion spaces that radiate serene sophistication and cutting-edge style.

With a transitional aesthetic, the Cadence collection fuses modern, organic forms with more classically inspired ideas. It draws its inspiration from a sophisticated blend of traditional diversity and modern minimalism. An homage to the beauty of juxtaposition- where the sleekness of contemporary design meets the warmth of classic aesthetics, creating a beautiful equilibrium. This balance not only enhances the architectural beauty of traditional spaces but also introduces a layer of modern allure.

The essence of the Cadence collection lies in its meticulous selection of materials like polished oak, brushed light bronze metal, pristine white marble and lustrous lacquers. Textural contrasts are emphasized with boucle fabrics, textured metals, glass embellishments, and Carrara marble, enriching the tactile and visual experience of each piece.

Highlights of the introductions include the Cadence Door Cabinet, a stunning, two door cabinet whose tall, molded doors embellished with a spherical, brushed brass disc hardware command attention. Other notable additions are the Cadence white lacquer cocktail tables featuring two surfaces of white lacquer pierced by three oak supports that are both structural and artistic, the Cadence round side table in oak finished in Sand ceruse and Mocha, and the Cadence Etagere which features Antique Brass metal with seeded glass shelves.

“It is not often that we have the chance to expand on a collection as quickly as we have with Cadence, layering into it immediately after the initial launch,” says Alex Shuford, President of Century Furniture. “While we knew stylistically we had a beautiful group it is always wonderful to be able to showcase it here at the High Point market and have our customers ask for more designs and then be able to work quickly to deliver those items to the marketplace as the collection begins to sell to consumers.”
