With a focus on artful exuberance, technological innovation, organic forms, and modernism, Hudson Valley Lighting Group (HVLG) is set to debut all-new designs for its Hudson Valley Lighting, Corbett Lighting, and Mitzi brand families this October at High Point Market, showcasing an elevated design perspective that combines artistry, innovation, and precious materials for a one-of-a-kind lighting experience.

Highlights include a new capsule with Becki Owens for Hudson Valley Lighting, new in-line fixtures from Hudson Valley Lighting and Corbett with an emphasis on LED integration, and the introduction of *THELIFESTYLEDCO®*'s Creative Director and Principal Designer Kristen Forgione as the newest creative for Mitzi's Tastemaker Series.

NEW FOR CORBETT LIGHTING

Setting the tone for exuberant living, **Corbett Lighting** introduces an assortment of botanically-inspired fixtures that rise to the height of glamor through exquisite materiality. Exuding drama and decadence, the **Cartagena** chandelier features tiers of lustrous leaf-shaped panels crafted from fine capiz shell, while an airy spray of delicate white glass flowers form the cloud-like silhouette of **Hygea** chandelier. Furthermore, technological innovation meets the natural world as the Ginkgo leaf-inspired **Nolita** sconce presents a ruffled leaf textured surface illuminated by G9 LED lighting.

Corbett also creatively enhances the perception of opulent, natural stones this season, with the **Tanzanite** sconce achieving visual interest through the incorporation of onyx and the **Hera** sconce presenting a curved backplate that bends around an alabaster light source. The **Bremen** sconce, another spotlight of dimensional beauty, hones in on the reminder of nature's power with a cast form displayed in the shape of fused, natural crystal, which is on the rise and trending.

Embodying the standard of refined luxury it's recognized for, Corbett sophisticatedly expresses elegance with an expanded line of geometric and celestial-inspired forms that shine with sumptuous simplicity. Standouts include the intricately crafted **Angelique** that showcases an artful and dynamic arrangement of gemstone-like pendants with their own unique proportions, and the cosmic inspired **Gleason** chandelier, which offers a show

stopping array of brass and cloud glass discs floating in a spherical silhouette, promising for visual excitement in any space.

This season, Hudson Valley Lighting is thrilled to present an all-new capsule with Southern California-based interior designer Becki Owens who continues to lend her coastal charm and inviting design approach to this sophisticated line of fixtures.

While reflecting on her own aesthetic, Owens' latest collection blends soft, on-trend silhouettes and clean lines with organic, raw textures to create designs that exude tranquility and ease. Standouts include the Eve pendant, which takes elegance to new heights by way of two new leafing techniques and a natural venetian plaster, as well as the Reina pendant

that exudes earthy modernism thanks to its highly textured, bleached rattan shade, uniquely made with a decorative loop that seamlessly blends with its metalwork.

With an emphasis on LED, Hudson Valley Lighting also adds to its in-line assortment with romantically inspired essentials that marry classic and forward-thinking silhouettes while intersecting performance and innovation. Drawing inspiration from stepping stones, the close-to-ceiling Holmdel pendants gracefully emulate a group formation of natural stones through the use of alabaster and energy efficient LED illumination, while the striking Homecrest sconce illustrates contrast by way of smooth and textured metal crescent plates and a LED candelabra bulb that creates a sunburst pattern glow on the backplate.

Hudson Valley Lighting continues exploring the contemporary trend of soft layers and repetitious forms this season with the Oneida family's debut, which unveils respective layers of vintage gold leaf tiers and sand-hued plates to create a streamlined direction of light, and with the introductions of the Esperance pendant and Bellarie and Oshawa table lamps, all of which showcase creative uses of material and texture to achieve stacked, sculptural appearances.

Further highlighting unique materiality, Hudson Valley Lighting creates striking contrast using ceramic and marble in new table lamps including Benicia, Ancram, Raiden and the globally-inspired Bayonne where natural rattan vines meet a black ceramic silhouette. The

brand also draws upon its timelessly tailored style foundation, debuting the Baltic chandelier, Lindenhurst sconce, Provincetown pendant and Westport family with the creative intention to give new life to classic interiors with cool, considered appreciation for a contemporary way of life.

NEW FOR MITZI



Renowned for her minimalist and contemporary approach to interior design, known as Organic Desert Living®, Interior Designer Kristen Forgione has reimagined warm, welcoming lighting for the modern home. Using natural materials, muted neutrals, and comforting textures, her versatile collection for Mitzi promises adventure, with unexpected focal points and beautiful craftsmanship to complement all interior styles. The collection includes 27 pieces ranging from impactful table lamps to captivating pendants.

The **Destiny** floor lamp plays to a lightweight and casual feel while combining a rich palette. With the desire for a highly textural finish but in a deeper, moodier color than the wicker or rattan of the past showcasing the aesthetic of organic desert living. While the **Annibee** pendant balances a delicate material mixed with a vintage inspired age. Forgione designed these with a minimal kitchen in mind but also recommends this pendant over a nightstand in a warm toned sleeping space or in a bathroom filled with natural stone!
