New Additions

Two years ago, Currey & Company introduced a flexible lighting system we call Multi-Drop Pendants. Although multi-drop lighting is not new to the industry, our focus on it is [took out new]. This stunning collection designed by Senior Designer Ian Thornton is a celebration of beautiful aesthetics, fine craftsmanship, sustainability, and the ultimate in versatility. With eight canopy options, a broad range of shade options, and adjustable wire lengths, each piece can be customized to fit any interior. These pendants are suited for residential or hospitality settings and can be used to create drama wherever they are installed.

This October, eight new shades and one new canopy have been added to the collection. The shades are hand-crafted of art glass, blown glass, Capiz shells, rattan, brass, pierced metal and glass beads. Currey's shades are distinctive and unlike any in the marketplace today. The company goes to great lengths to create shades from interesting natural materials that other manufacturers regard as too difficult or too time-consuming.

The new Palatino Multi-Drop Pendant is a perfect example of exquisite glass handiwork. The shades give the impression they are their own complete universe replete with its own Milky Way. Made of two layers of glass—the interior white and the exterior blue—the shade shimmers with Mica dust that is tossed and rolled onto the surface of the molten glass, which is twisted and turned to achieve the swirls that mimic the wonders of the night sky. The surface glimmers even when the lights are switched off.
