Best known for her twist on modern elegance, Allison continues to excite her audience with pieces that combine glamour and comfort with a hint of exotic. In her 11th appearance at the High Point Market in the E.J. Victor showroom Allison will lead her guests on a glamorous journey as she presents her lines newest additions, the Heidi Bench, Robbie Chair, Robbie Sofa and additional Richie Dining Table.

The Heidi Bench is visually decadent with its luxurious cut velvet fabric in beige with a pop of turquoise in a graphic pattern. The aluminum base is accented with a delicate sparkle and brushed in antique silver leaf. This designer favorite can be ordered with the fabric seat or replaced with stone or glass and converted to a side table.



The Robbie chair and sofa offers a unique twist of structure, sculpture and comfort in a transitional style. The perfect depth for anyone! The sofa features a reinterpreted camel back, while the chair combines a masculine structure with feminine curves. Both of these pieces are grounded with a beautiful warm walnut base and wedge feet.






In the dining room, the spotlight will be on the additional square Richie Dining Table, Paladino's modern take on a kiss, with an X-shaped base. This market she introduces the square, 66 inched table in a beautiful warm medium walnut with a reverse miter top accent.

Enhancing the visual allure of the showcase room will be her newest hand-tufted area rug with New River Artisans, Post Modern. This new addition will round out her rug collection to six spectacular pieces available in 30 different colors. "It was only natural for me to move from designing furniture to the walls and to the floor," Paladino relates. "The new rug palette is serene, quiet and beautifully elegant, and I'm incredibly

excited about the greatly reduced lead times this North Carolina-based Company offers. New River is putting all of the custom rug companies overseas on notice. Where typical lead times average 5 to 6 months from overseas, and designers have to worry about things getting caught in customs, New River Artisans deliver strike-offs in one to two weeks, and completed area rugs in six to eight. The Post Modern rug as well as the rest is made from New Zealand wool and entirely vegetable dyed. The design portion of the rug is made of a cut pile while the field is in a loop.



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
