My one tip would be to go with someone who has been to market several times if possible. I was lucky and had dear friends help me navigate market for the first couple of times. It's like going on a trip. It's always more fun (and more time effective) to explore a new destination with natives.

And save your battery - the first thing you want to do is to turn bluetooth and WIFI off at the beginning of the day and put your battery on low power mode. I found myself being able to keep it going for the entire day that way. Only turn WIFI on if you need to upload anything to social and have it all ready to go when you do (pre-write posts in your notes with your hashtags).

If the place you are going is not one of the shuttle stops, call the GO-Anywhere shuttle & it will come pick you up. Sometimes there's a bit of a wait though.



Always go to Market with a plan. Use the MyMarket app to set up your schedule ahead of time. However, it is so easy to lose track of time when you're walking through so many hallways full of inspiration. Also, you're going to run into so many people that you see on social media all the time. You'll definitely spend some time chatting and taking photos together. Saving money at the Market is easy. Eat and drink in the showrooms. Many of the showrooms offer amazing food catered by local chefs and restaurants. Take advantage of that.

You save time by planning ahead and visit exhibitors by neighborhood so that you don't continuously run back and forth. Your feet will be grateful, trust me. You save money by eating and drinking in showrooms instead of anywhere else. All the showrooms offer snacks, drinks and food during various hours of the day. I have never left a day at market hungry. Also, if you are on the hunt for certain furniture pieces, ask the showrooms if they sell their display pieces. If you organize the pickup yourself, there usually is a steep discount available for those.

Efficiency in all aspects is the name of the game at Market. Make good choices, pack snacks, and come with a plan.

Save time by having a plan. You cannot see it all! Focus on lighting or art – plan that ahead of time. Know the districts and plan around that. Wear comfortable shoes and carry a tote bag so you're able to transition quickly to parties. Save money by renting a house that can accommodate more people. And make use of the transportation trollies. Some showrooms will even come pick you up!

One of the best way to save time at Market is to make appointments with your reps ahead of time. You can always call or email showrooms to find out who they are if you're not sure. Plan to be intentional about your agenda in the interest of time, especially if you're not staying the entire Market week.
